Annex 11 - Training

- A. The training of response personnel is essential for the implementation of emergency response plans. The Director, West Virginia Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management is responsible for assuring that training is offered on an annual basis for appropriate individuals.
- B. Two types of training will be offered; a basic core course, with five modules, and an advanced course, with three modules. Annual retraining will consist at a mininum of a refresher of basic course modulesPersonnel may retake the courses or select modules as often as they desire. Personnel are further advised to take FEMA training on REP issues, as desired.
